



**DAYBOAT WEEK 2017 17<sup>th</sup> - 22<sup>nd</sup> June**

The host club for Dayboat Week will be The Royal Cornwall Yacht Club (RCYC) which is situated in the Packet Quays area of Falmouth (post code TR11 2SP).

**Events**

Included in the Notice of Race you will find a schedule of events for the week which includes the 'on the water' events and the evening social events in the clubhouse. The clubhouse will be open every day for drinks and food after sailing.

**Moorings**

RCYC will be laying mooring buoys (trots) just off the club wall so that each of our boats will be afloat all week on their own mooring and the club launch and safety boats will ferry crews from the club wall to our boats each day. Launching on arrival and haul out on departure will be from the Watersports' Centre.

**Racing**

Racing during the week will be in the areas marked on the Indicative Course Area photograph, mainly using areas 2, 3, and 4, with course 1 being used only if conditions are favourable in the bay. The course for the Long Distance Race will be set during the week with the intention to sail to a destination (e.g. pub for refreshments) then return to RCYC.

**Accommodation and parking**

There are no parking facilities at the club and street parking is limited. For accommodation away from the club which requires transport, there are long stay car parks within walking distance of the club and weekly tickets can be purchased.

**Falmouth (General)**

As mentioned in Dayboat Notes, the weekend of the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> June promises to be quite eventful for Falmouth - as we arrive in Falmouth on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> June, the town will already be buzzing from their annual International Sea Shanty Festival. Not only that, the Falmouth Classics event will be racing and cruising in the River Fal and the bay - both events run from Friday 16<sup>th</sup> to Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> June. From Monday 19<sup>th</sup>, the Dayboat fleet is the main attraction!

**Entry Fee**

The entry fee of £230 per boat includes the following:

- 2 tickets for the reception buffet on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup>
- 2 tickets for the prize- giving dinners on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup>
- Launching, haul out and mooring charges and trailer storage
