# At Salcombe Yacht Club Saturday 6 – Thursday 11 June 2015 NOTICE OF RACE and ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

#### 1 GENERAL

The organising authority will be the Salcombe Yacht Club (SYC) in conjunction with the Yachting World Dayboat Association (YWDBA). All competitors and their friends will be honorary members of SYC for the duration of this event.

#### 2 **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 2.1 All races will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013 2016, RYA prescriptions and applicable YWDBA rules, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions, Entry Form and any Notices to Competitors posted in SYC.
- 2.2 The event is open to all boats having current Race Certificates issued by the Yachting World Dayboat Association. Any person helming in any race (including the subsidiary races) must be a member of the Association.
- 2.3 Boats must be insured against claims by third parties of not less than £3,000,000 for the duration of the event.
- 2.4 By participating in a race conducted under these rules each competitor and boat owner agrees :
  - (i) to be governed by the above rules
  - (ii) to accept the penalties imposed and other action taken in accordance with the rules, subject to the appeal and review procedures provided in them, as the final determination of any matter arising under the rules;
  - (iii) with respect to such a determination, not to resort to any court or tribunal not provided by the rules.
  - (iv) that Salcombe Yacht Club reserves the right to make any alterations it may deem necessary.
- 2.5 Any collision with a non-competing boat, whether it be underway or moored,

must be reported to the Harbour Office and recorded on the appropriate Form. Any competitor colliding with a moored boat must complete a 360 degree penalty turn. Any boats observed colliding with a moored boats and not reporting the incident will be disqualified from the Race, at the Race Officer's discretion.

#### 3 ENTRIES

- 3.1 Advance entries can be made until 1 May 2015 using the enclosed Entry Form accompanied by a cheque for the Entry Fee. After 1 May 2015 entries will be accepted at the discretion of the organisers upon payment of an extra fee of £20.00.
- 3.2 The Entry fee includes two tickets per boat for the social events as shown on the attached Sailing/Social Programme. Additional tickets are available and can be booked and paid for on or before Saturday 6 June 2015,

#### 4 PROGRAMME

- 4.1 The provisional Sailing/Social Programme is set out on the attached schedule.
- 4.2 Registration will take place at SYC between 1600-1800 hours on Saturday 6 June 2015. Sailing Instructions will be available at the club. There will be a briefing for competitors in the Clubhouse before the Commodore's Reception.

#### 5 BERTHING and OTHER ARANGEMENTS

- 5.1 Dayboats will be berthed on a pontoon (accessible from shore) in Batson Creek, where there is a large car/boat park and launching slipway. Some berths may dry out at some states of tide. Berthing fees for 6-11 June inclusive are included in the Entry Fee, but any boat arriving before Friday 5 June or staying after Friday 12 June may incur an additional fee, payable to the Harbour Master.
- 5.2 Helms wishing to dry sail may keep boats in the Batson Creek boat park: this will incur a charge (£46.60 in 2014) bookable and payable directly to South Hams District Council. Entrants not using the pontoon berths will be reimbursed the sum of £15.

#### **6 LIABILITY EXCLUSION**

6.1 A boat is entirely responsible for her own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility.

- 6.2 It shall be the sole responsibility of each helm to decide whether or not to start or to continue to race and to decide whether the boat is fit to sail in the conditions in which she will find herself. By launching or going to sea, the helm confirms that the boat is fit for those conditions and her helm and crew are competent to sail and compete in them.
- 6.4 Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the boat nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The term 'organisers' encompasses all persons helping to run the race and the event, and includes the organising authority, the race committee, the race officer, patrol boats and beach-masters.
- 6.5 The provision of patrol boats does not relieve the boat of her responsibility.
- 6.6 The fact that the race committee conducts inspections of a boat does not reduce the responsibilities of the boat set out in this paragraph.

#### 7 RIGHTS TO USE NAMES AND LIKENESSES.

Competitors automatically grant SYC and YWDBA without payment the right in perpetuity to make use and show and receive payment therefore, of any motion pictures, still pictures and live filmed or taped television of or relating to the event. They also allow their names, age, category, Club and Boat details to be displayed in competitor lists prior to the event and in results and on the YW Dayboat Association website and in any other publication.
